ABOUT THE LAB

ROUGH CUT LAB AFRICA (RCLA) WAS CONCEIVED AND IMPLEMENTED BY DOCUMENTARY FILMMAKER AND EDITOR KHALID SHAMIS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SOUTH AFRICAN GUILD OF EDITORS (SAGE) AND THE ENCOUNTERS SOUTH AFRICAN INTERNATIONAL DOCUMENTARY FILM FESTIVAL (ENCOUNTERS) IN 2017.

WE HAD IDENTIFIED THE NEED FOR SUCH AN INTERVENTION BECAUSE ACCESS TO EXPERT INDUSTRY ADVICE FROM OUTSIDE OF 'FIRST WORLD' CONSULTATIVE FRAMEWORKS DURING THE FINAL EDITING STAGES OF A PROJECT IS INSTRUMENTAL TO SHAPING THE SUCCESS OF DOCUMENTARY FILMS AS FILMMAKERS COMPLETE THEIR VISION WITH INTEGRITY AND ENTER THE MARKETPLACE.

RCLA RECOGNISES THE NEED FOR FILMMAKERS ON THE CONTINENT TO HAVE SECURE, WELL VERSED AND WELL RESOURCED SUPPORTING KNOWLEDGE OF EDITING AND STORY CONSTRUCTION THROUGH CONSULTATION AND MENTORSHIP. WE ARE VERY WELL SUPPORTED ON THE CONTINENT WHEN IT COMES TO DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES AND SUPPORTIVE PRODUCTION INITIATIVES, BUT SOMEHOW WE ARE LACKING WHEN IT COMES TO STORY EDITING AND CONSTRUCTION. MORE OFTEN THAN NOT OUR FILMS ARE CONSTRUCTED AND FINISHED OUTSIDE OF THE CONTINENT, WHILE BEING BENEFICIAL OVERALL FOR THE FILM PROJECT, LEAVES US IN A DEFICIT AND A RELIANCE ON OUTSIDE STORY SUPPORT WHICH EXACERBATES HISTORICAL RELATIONSHIPS OF RELIANCE ON THE GLOBAL NORTH.

RCLA ENSURES EQUITABLE ACCESS TO AFRICAN STORY CONSULTATION AND POST-PRODUCTION PROFESSIONALS TO CONTRIBUTE TO A DIVERSE TALENT PIPELINE FOR EMERGING EDITORS AND TO CONNECT WITH POST-PRODUCTION PROFESSIONALS ACROSS THE AFRICAN CONTINENT AND THE GLOBAL SOUTH.

LAB DIRECTOR

LONDON BORN LIBYAN-CAPETONIAN, KHALID SHAMIS IS A DOCUMENTARY DIRECTOR, FILMS EVERY YEAR AS PRODUCER AND EDITOR WITH A FILMMAKING PRACTICE SPANNING OVER "STRANGE PLACE OF MORE THAN 25 YEARS. HE DIRECTING DIRECTORS, STUDIED FILM LANGUAGE IN LONDON, WORKED IN THE FILM INDUSTRIES OF THE UK, MIDDLE EAST AND SOUTHERN AFRICA AND NOW RUNS HIS PRODUCTION COMPANY TUBAFILMS FROM CAPE TOWN. HIS DIRECTING WORK INCLUDES 'IMAM AND I'. 2011 AND 'THE COLONEL'S STRAY DOGS', 2021. KHALID WORKS AND RESEARCHES AS A DOCTORAL FELLOW AT THE CENTRE FOR HUMANITIES RESEARCH CHR) AT THE UNIVERSITY OF THE WESTERN CAPE.

KHALID'S PRACTICE IS STRONGLY DEDICATED TO THE PEDAGOGY OF INDEPENDENT FILMMAKING AND STORY CONSTRUCTION IN AFRICA, TEACHING AND CONSULTING IN AND OUTSIDE FILM INSTITUTIONS AND ORGANIZED FRAMEWORKS. HE DESCRIBES HIS PRACTICE IN HIS OWN WORDS AS MOVING AT VASTLY DIFFERENT PACES: WHILE HIS OWN FILMS HAVE TAKEN UP TO


SEVEN YEARS TO FINISH. HE CONSTRUCTS AND COMPLETES NUMEROUS AN EDITOR, TURNING HIS PRACTICE INTO A GUIDING FIRST TIME FILMMAKERS. IMBIBING WORLDS ALIEN TO [HIS] OWN, CONTAINING AND CREATING ANOTHER'S VISION, MANIFESTING THE DREAMS OF THE SUBJECTS IN THE FILMS AND BEING TAKEN BY THE VOICE OF THE MATERIAL ITSELF".

KAMAL ALJAFARI IS A PALESTINIAN FILMMAKER RENOWNED FOR HIS DISTINCTIVE APPROACH TO CINEMA. AFTER STUDYING AT THE ACADEMY OF MEDIA ARTS IN COLOGNE, HE NOW RESIDES IN BERLIN, GERMANY. ALJAFARI HAS SHARED HIS EXPERTISE IN FILMMAKING THROUGH TEACHING POSITIONS AT THE NEW SCHOOL IN NEW YORK AND THE DEUTSCHE FILM-UND FERNSEHAKADEMIE IN BERLIN. HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE FIELD WERE RECOGNISED WITH A FELLOWSHIP AT THE FILM STUDY CENTER RADCLIFFE AT HARVARD UNIVERSITY. IN 2021, THE OLHAR DE CINEMA - CURITIBA

INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL IN BRAZIL HIGHLIGHTED HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO CINEMA BY DEDICATING ITS FOCUS SECTION TO HIS WORK. ALJAFARI RECENTLY COMPLETED 'A FIDAI FILM' AND IS CURRENTLY DEVELOPING A FICTION FILM SET TO BE SHOT IN JAFFA.

CONSULTANTS VARA COSTA IS A MOZAMBICAN FILMMAKER AND ARTIST WHOSE WORK IS DEEPLY ROOTED IN UNTOLD NARRATIVES INVISIBILIZED BY COLONIAL RULE AND WHITE SUPREMACY. HER WORK REFLECTS HER QUESTIONS ABOUT THE REALITY OF CONTEMPORARY POST-COLONIAL AFRICA CONNECTING TO THE PAST AND REIMAGINED FUTURE AND THROUGH CINEMA SHE WISHES TO SHARE HER WORLDVIEW. HER LATEST FILM, "BETWEEN GOD AND ME", TELLS THE STORY OF KAREN, A YOUNG INDEPENDENT MUSLIM WHO DEFENDS SHARIA IN THE MULTICULTURAL ISLAND OF MOZAMBIQUE, BUT IS FULL OF DOUBTS AND CONTRADICTIONS ABOUT HER IDENTITY AND THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH SHE LIVES. THE FILM PREMIERED AT DOCLISBOA IN 2018 AND TOURED AROUND 40 COUNTRIES AT SEVERAL INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVALS. AFTER AN EXTENSION COURSE AT THE CUBAN FILM SCHOOL, IN 2011, HE PRODUCED AND PRODUCED "THE CROSSING", FOR THE ALJAZEERA TELEVISION NETWORK, A SHORT FILM ABOUT THE TENSIONS BETWEEN HAITI AND THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, TOLD THROUGH THE PERSONAL STORY OF A HAITIAN STUDENT WHO CROSSED THE BORDER DAILY TO GO TO SCHOOL. HER FIRST FILM, DIRECTED AND PRODUCED BY HER, "WHY HERE? STORIES OF CHINESE IN AFRICA", REVOLVES AROUND THE PERSONAL STORIES OF 3 CHINESE IMMIGRANTS IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF AFRICA. YARA IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON 3 DIFFERENT PROJECTS, INCLUDING A FEATURE-LENGTH FICTION, BY A PAN-AFRICAN COLLECTIVE CO-PRODUCED BETWEEN MOZAMBIQUE, SOUTH AFRICA AND THE USA, AN IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCE ART INSTALLATION "NAKHODA AND THE MERMAID" ABOUT THE CULTURAL HERITAGE OF THE COASTAL PEOPLES AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL AND CULTURAL GENOCIDE THAT IS CURRENTLY TAKING PLACE IN NORTHERN MOZAMBIQUE, AND THE FILM "LOOKING FOR THE MERMAID", CURRENTLY IN DEVELOPMENT.



INADELSO COSSA IS A FILM DIRECTOR, PRODUCER AND DOP, MEMBER OF THE (AMPAS) ACADEMY OF MOTION PICTURE ARTS AND SCIENCE SINCE 2020. FOUNDER OF 16MMFILMES A PRODUCTION COMPANY FOCUS ON CREATIVE DOCUMENTARY AND FEATURE FILMS. HIS FILMS ADDRESS THEMES SUCH AS POST-COLONIAL MEMORY, POST-CIVIL WAR TRAUMA, SILENT VOICES AND COLLECTIVE AMNESIA IN MOZAMBIQUE. THE UNOFFICIAL HISTORY OF HIS COUNTRY IS ALMOST ALWAYS THE VEHICLE OF HIS CINEMA WHERE THE DIRECTOR POSITIONS HIMSELF ON A PERSONAL PERSPECTIVE. HIS FIRST FEATURE-LENGTH DOCUMENTARY: A MEMORY IN THREE ACTS MADE A WORLD PREMIERE AT THE FESTIVAL IDFA - INTERNATIONAL DOCUMENTARY FESTIVAL IN AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS. THE FILM WAS SELECTED FOR DURBAN FILM MART 2014, AND LOCARNO OPEN DOORS 2014. WON THE JURY SPECIAL AWARD AT THE ZANZIBAR INT. FILM FESTIVAL IN 2018 AND THE FLEMISH COMMISSION FOR UNESCO AT AFRIKA FILM FESTIVAL LEUVEN, BELGIUM 2020. TIAGO CORREIA-PAULO IS A LATE SEVENTIES BABY WHO HAILS FROM MAPUTO, MOZAMBIQUE. HE 'WASTED' A BUNCH OF TIME STUDYING DEVELOPMENT ECONOMICS AND HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT IN SOUTH AFRICA TO LATER DISCOVER THAT HE ACTUALLY WANTED TO BECOME A MUSICIAN. OR SOMETHING LIKE THAT. BASED IN JOHANNESBURG, HE STARTED A COUPLE OF BANDS SO HE COULD RECORD ALBUMS, GO ON TOUR, AND DO ALL THE THINGS YOUR CONVENTIONAL MUSICIAN DOES. LATER, BORED WITH THE ONE DIMENSIONAL ASPECT OF BEING IN BANDS. HE STARTED WORKING BY HIMSELF ON FILM SCORES AND OTHER MUSICAL EXPERIMENTATIONS, NOT LONG AFTER, AND ALMOST INSTINCTIVELY, HE ENDS UP BRIDGING OTHER INCLINATIONS LIKE DESIGN, ILLUSTRATION AND EDITING, AND DIVES HEAD FIRST INTO THE WORLD OF FILM MAKING. HE'S CURRENTLY AN INTEGRAL PART OF A FEW MUSICAL VENTURES, HAS HIS OWN ELECTRONIC SOLO ENDEAVOR. BUILT A STUDIO WHERE HE WORKS WITH AND PRODUCES OTHER ARTISTS, AND SPENDS A FAIR AMOUNT OF TIME WORKING ON FILM SCORES AND SOUNDSCAPES FOR A WIDE ARRAY OF PROJECTS.





'LAND OF DREAMS AND NIGHTMARES' EXPLORES THE CONTRASTING PERSPECTIVES OF TWO INDIVIDUALS, KAYAL AND BASSMA, AS THEY NAVIGATE LIFE IN CAIRO WORKING ON A FILM SCHOOL ASSIGNMENT DOCUMENTING THEIR PERSPECTIVES TOWARDS THE CITY. DELVING INTO THEMES OF IDENTITY, BELONGING AND THE PURSUIT OF DREAMS AMIDST THE COMPLEXITIES OF URBAN LIFE, OFFERING PERSONAL REFLECTIONS ON THE REALITIES OF LIVING IN A CITY FILLED WITH BOTH PROMISE AND PERIL.





IT WAS ONLY AFTER THE 2011 UPRISING THAT MARWAN WITNESSED MOST OF HIS GENERATION'S FAMILY MEMBERS LEAVE THE COUNTRY TO PURSUE MORE FRUITFUL AND COMFORTABLE LIVES IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE WORLD.




